We are now halfway through the 3rd quarter of school and it is a wonderful time to look at our students' progress so far this year. We have learned colors, numbers, shapes, animals, body parts, clothing, calendar items, as well as, common Spanish greetings and phrases.

Students grades 4-8 have been introduced to verb conjugation. They have also been assigned homework assignments every week or so and are regularly given quizzes on previously learned topics. For the most part this has been a successful process, helping students to learn responsibility and review of past materials.
